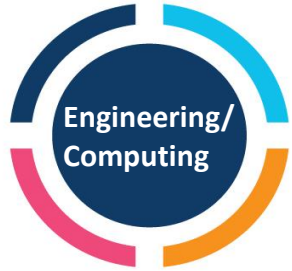

## Overall Objective of the Facilitated Discussions

**To develop a 2.0 work plan for the Collaborative to help inform future proposals, projects and priorities.**

The general objectives and outcomes of facilitated 2.0 planning discussions are intended to result in summary report outlining outcomes, decisions, opportunities and relative feedback to inform revised work plan and grant proposals and include the following:

- To prepare Collaborative for **growth beyond the pilot** and areas to be decided upon in the affirmative– **Pathways, Student Targets, Definition of “Regional 2.0” (partners, governance, composition)**
- To develop a better understanding of the **Collaborative’s success, challenges and opportunities**
- To be in **structural alignment with legislation** for K16 collaborative funding (**board composition and structure**).
- To be **positioned to expand collaboration** with mission aligned institutions and organizations
- To **inform a proposal** to be submitted seeking to secure a portion of the \$250M for K16 collaboratives that includes incorporating stakeholder wisdom and similar practices in the field and includes taking promising programs to scale
- To help in the development of a robust program model based on learnings from a pilot phase. **summarize recommendations and observations**

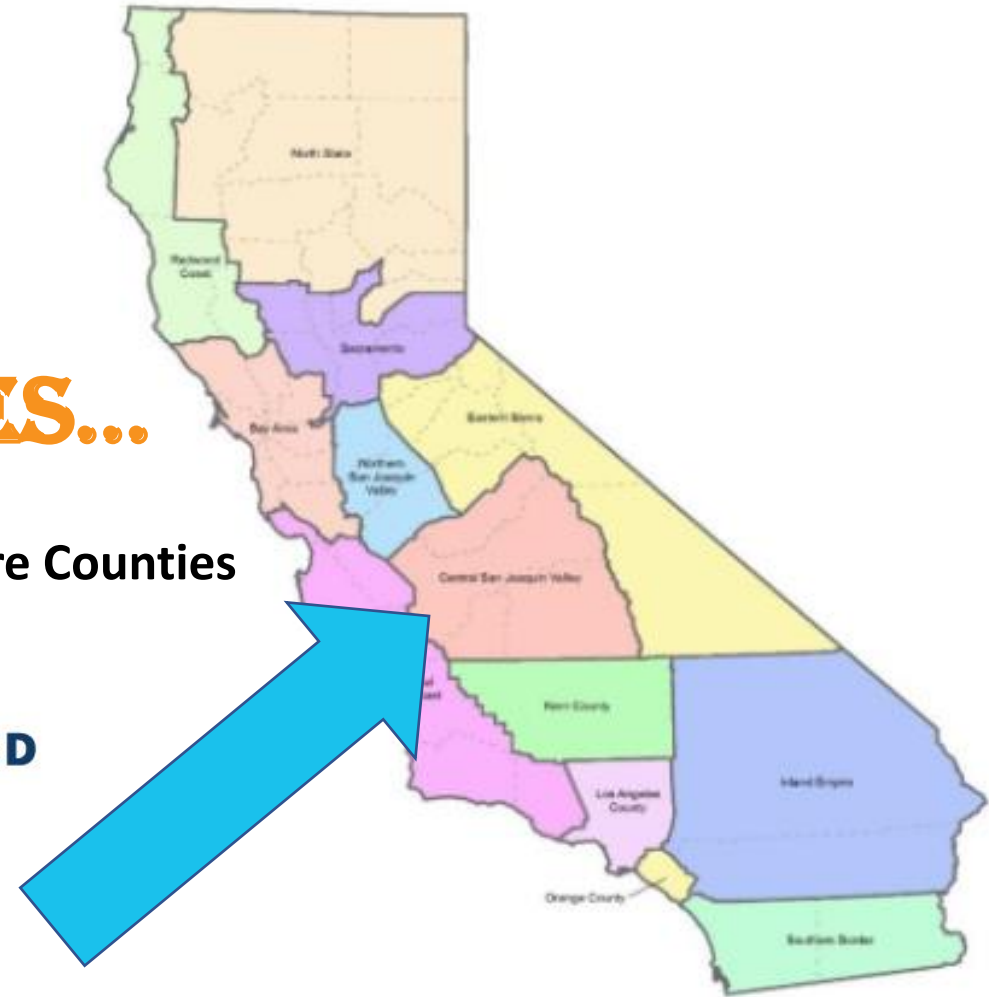

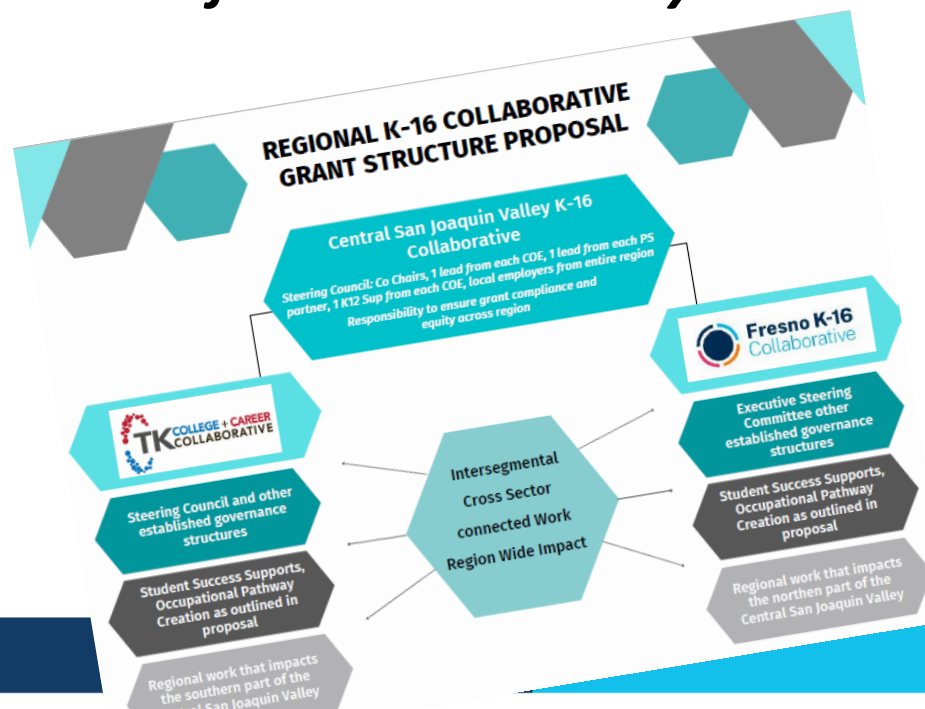

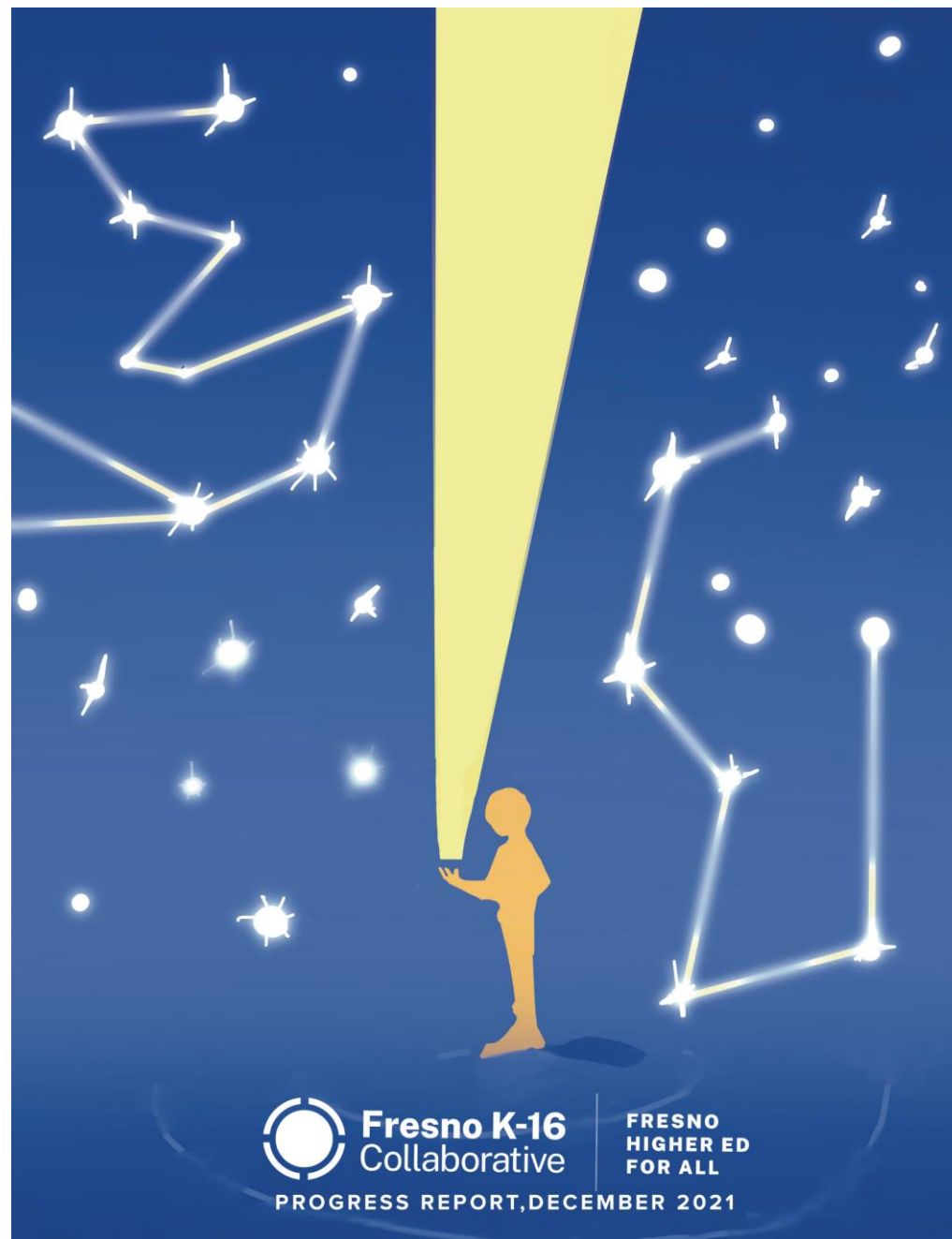
